Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; in all your ways know him, and he will make your paths straight. -Proverbs 3:5-6

We are in uncertain times. It's natural to feel worried. It's also natural to rely on our own abilities to maintain peace and fix the situation we are worried about. The Lord tells us to trust in Him. Note, that does not mean we do nothing. It's quite the opposite. We trust Him. We live like He wants us to live. We love Him with our lives and we love others as we would want to be loved. The results are His. We are His and anything that belongs to God is well cared for.
